



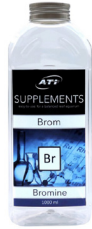
Elements



Boron

Boron is absorbed by coral. As a buffering agent, it can help prevent large pH swings in aquarium water.

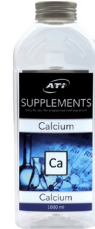

Bromine

Bromine is used in some corals for chromoprotein synthesis and for skeleton construction.

Calcium

Calcium is a crucial element for stony corals, clams, and calcareous algae.
